- 5. Drainage Program
 - a. Motion to approve entering into an Amendment (1) for SVWID Professional Services Agreement – ESA – Tuck Creek Replacements 2023-02 for final designs and permits, in an amount not to exceed commercial services funds allocated in King County Flood Control District Flood Reduction Fund Award #4.23.11 was made, seconded, and approved 5:0.
